# **Treatment objectives:**

**Black wounds** 

Removement of black necrosis

Yellow wounds

Removement of yellow fibrin layer/pus

**Red wounds** 

Acceleration/protection red granulation tissue

**Pink wounds** 

**Acceleration/protection pink re-epitheliliazation** To achieve complete healing/hydration healed skin with hydrating skin cream
